## **Individual Response Paper: Accessibility Information for Prospective Students**

## **Exercise**

The objective of this activity is to apply what you have learned about the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and accessibility at Kalamazoo College. Your task is to write a statement for prospective students laying out what information that a student with a disability would need to know about accessibility and accommodations on campus. Unless you have studied these things about other campuses, you are not able to tell prospective students they should or should not come to K. It is your job to lay out the information so that they may make their own informed decision.

Your paper should be 2-3 pages in length (double-spaced. 12-pt font, 1" margins). If you find that you have a lot to say to cover every disability, you might consider focusing your paper on a smaller set of disabilities. Your paper should include the following:

- An introduction to the document.
- A discussion of accessibility issues and accommodations available on campus for students with disabilities.
- A summary/conclusion of what the prospective student should consider when making their decision about coming to K.

Bring 2 printed copies of your paper to class with you on Wednesday Week 6. We will be doing some peer review and then you will make revisions.

When you are done with revisions, submit the final version of your paper in pdf format via Kit.
